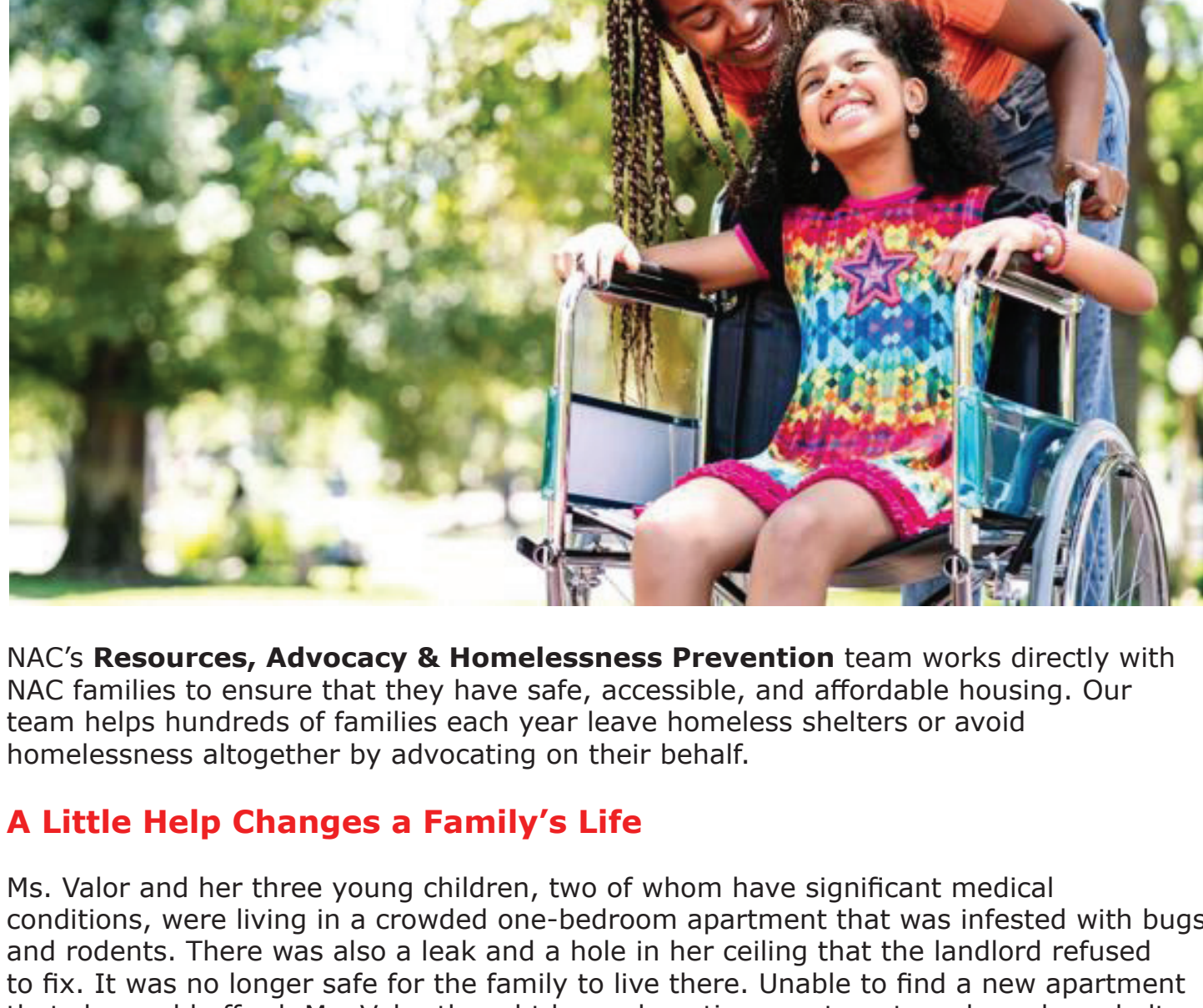

RESOURCES, ADVOCACY & HOMELESSNESS PREVENTION



NAC's **Resources, Advocacy & Homelessness Prevention** team works directly with NAC families to ensure that they have safe, accessible, and affordable housing. Our team helps hundreds of families each year leave homeless shelters or avoid homelessness altogether by advocating on their behalf.

A Little Help Changes a Family's Life

Ms. Valor and her three young children, two of whom have significant medical conditions, were living in a crowded one-bedroom apartment that was infested with bugs and rodents. There was also a leak and a hole in her ceiling that the landlord refused to fix. It was no longer safe for the family to live there. Unable to find a new apartment that she could afford, Ms. Valor thought her only option was to enter a homeless shelter with her children.

NAC's **Resources, Advocacy & Homelessness Prevention Program** became involved immediately. It was imperative that they help the family find a new apartment as soon as possible. Our housing coordinator was able to complete an intake assessment and provide resources and help through the Family Homelessness and Eviction Prevention Supplement application, stressing the families' need for relocation due to unsafe conditions.

After an extensive search to find the family the best housing possible, a new 3-bedroom apartment was found that would allow all of the children to have adequate room and space to grow. The lease was signed and a move-in date was scheduled within the month.

Through a special emergency grant fund, NAC was also able to help the family with moving expenses and even buy them new beds! Through this work, NAC was able to **ensure that the family remained together and out of the shelter system**. We wish them nothing but joy in their new home!

SUMMER IN THE CITY

For over 40 Years, NAC has helped New York City's most vulnerable children escape the city heat while attending summer camp and this year was no exception. With the incredible support of the NAC community, we were able to **send over 100 children to camp** for a life-changing experience they are sure to remember!

We also provided lots of activities for NAC kids staying closer to home this summer. Our summer youth programs were in full swing with activities for our youth of all ages. NAC kids learned all about fire safety at the **FDNY Fire Zone**, spent time at the **Bronx Zoo**, and had their imaginations take flight at the **Intrepid Sea, Air, & Space Museum**.

Volunteers from **PIMCO** were on hand at our new offices to host Dino-Mite, a day of learning and fun. NAC kids had the chance to learn all about dinosaurs, play pin-the-head on the dino, and create their very own, hand-painted dinosaur models to take home.

Our pre-teen and teen groups had the opportunity to go on several field trips throughout the summer, enjoying both their time together and a sense of community with one another. Trips included bowling and gaming at **Bowlero** Chelsea Piers, learning and exploring at the **Hall of Science Museum**, enjoying a day out in nature at the **Queens Botanical Gardens**, and a day of rides and fun at historic **Rye Playland**.

It was an amazing summer for NAC kids and we are grateful for all the support we receive from our community to help make that possible.

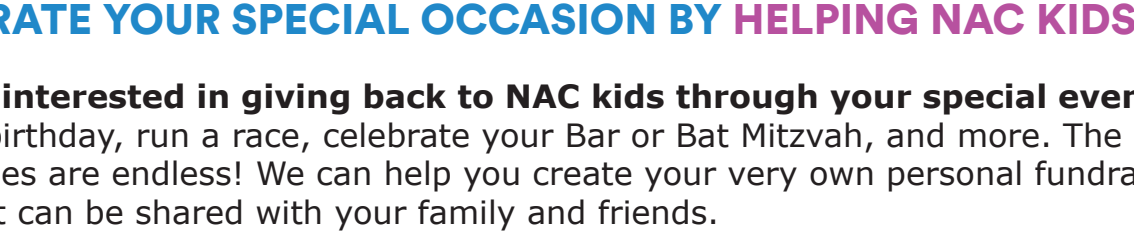
